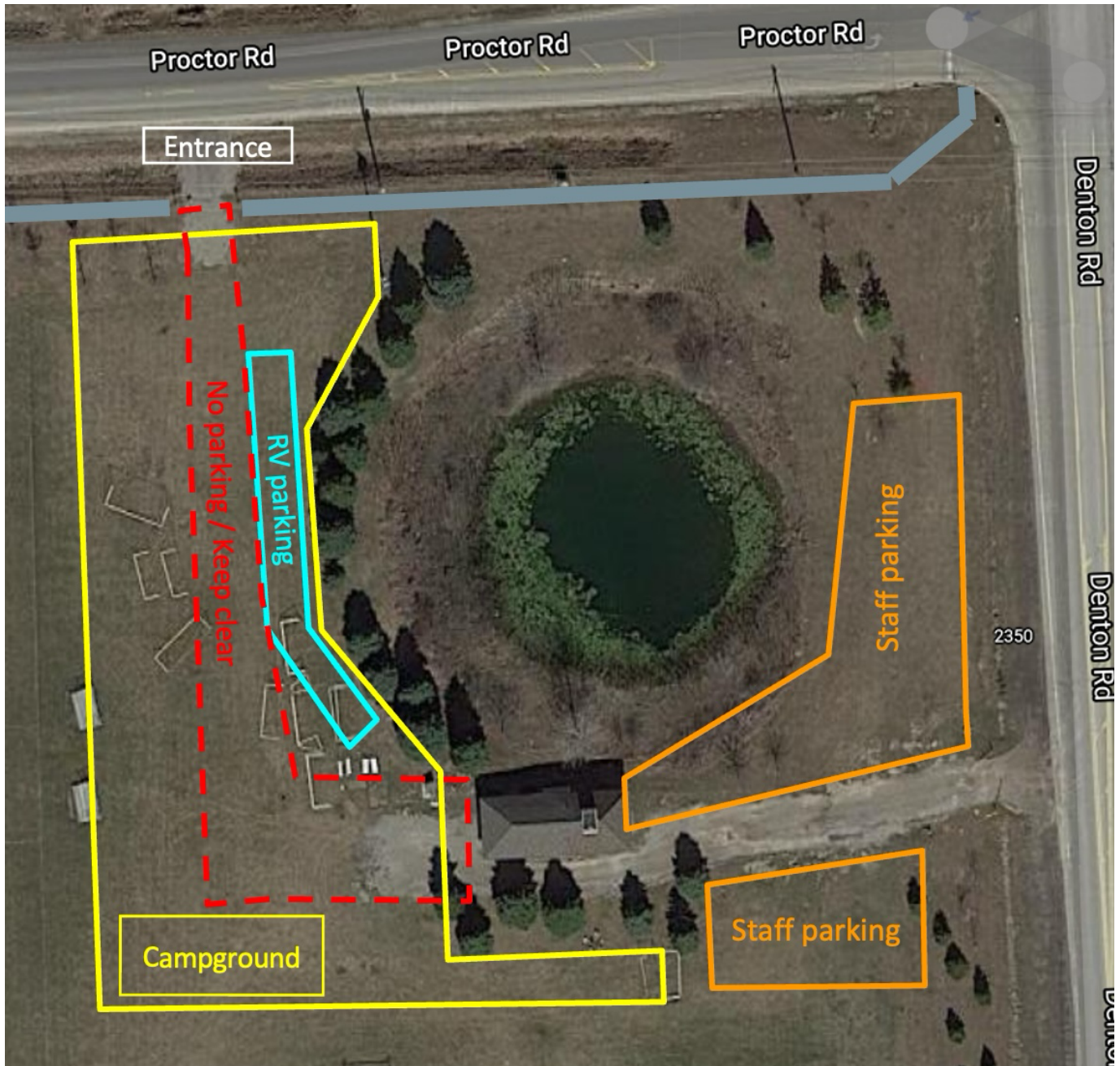




CAMPING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES

Camping Location: Camper parking is at the NE corner of Independence Park. Refer to the map for details. Sites will be assigned based on this year's RV sizes.



Camper Requirements: The unit must be self-contained as we do not have water or sewer hookups. We will be offering unlimited use of our generator for an electrical hookup ([CLICK HERE FOR CONNECTION TYPES](#)).

Additional Vehicles & guests: Parking is VERY limited. You will receive one parking pass per campsite. Parking will likely not be available immediately next to your camper. If you will be bringing an additional vehicle or having guests, there is additional parking across the street on the north side of Proctor Road.

Prior to your Arrival: You need to have agreed to a scheduled time slot prior to tournament weekend. Upon arrival, you will receive your parking pass that will need to be displayed on the front dash of the vehicle you will be parking in the campground. You will not be allowed to park your camper, or car, without being Paid-in-Full.

Arrival Time: You will be assigned a scheduled window for your arrival. Based on that window, I will work with you to confirm an ETA so I can schedule others accordingly. All RV's must be parked by the end of the day Thursday.

- Scheduled arrival times will vary between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm on Thursday and are dependent on where you are placed by the Canton Cup staff.
- If you can't arrive during your scheduled arrival time, you will need to make special arrangements in advance with the Canton Cup staff.
- We recommend that you call 10-15 minutes prior to your arrival to help us prepare for you.
- A Canton Cup representative will meet you and direct you to your parking location.

Electrical Service: We will be offering full electrical service to all campsites. The [RV HOOKUP](#) document details the exact RV electrical connection that we will be providing. **All of our hookups are 50 amp connections.** If your camper has a 30 amp plug, you will need to supply a 50A to 30A converter. There will also be 15/20 amp service (lights, fridge, etc.) available if that's all you require.

Departure: You are welcome to stay until 12:00 noon on Monday. The generator will remain operational until 8:00 am Monday. Please do not attempt to leave while the tournament is still in progress.
